This year's symposium has been designed to address key Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), focusing on skills and employability, technology and climate, and access to public health. Whether it's exploring the competencies employers seek, examining how Al can sustain climate action, or showcasing innovations that make public

health more accessible, we aim to delve into the ideas that engage us daily—and sometimes keep us up at night.

Throughout the evening, we will engage in insightful and interactive discussions, with ample opportunities to network with peers and leaders from industry and government. We will also introduce you to the Alumni UK platform, which offers a range of professional trainings, awards, and more.

This symposium comes at an exciting time: The British Council and the Government of Karnataka's Higher Education Department have recently launched four flagship programmes in the state, under a Memorandum of Understanding signed earlier this year.

These include:

- The GREAT Scholars for Outstanding Undergraduate Talent (SCOUT) programme, which will send 30 students from Karnataka to the University of East London for a certified course on sustainability in the context of business and entrepreneurship.
- The English Skills for Youth programme with Microsoft, benefiting over 5,700 students from 16
 engineering colleges across the state, to enhance their English language and communication
 skills for better employability.
- A capacity-building programme for 56 international officers across 28 public universities in the state, supporting the Government of Karnataka's internationalisation goals.
- The first digital wall from the British Council digital library, housed at Bengaluru City University's campus, providing students across Karnataka with access to high-quality content.

Our work with you, the UK alumni, extends across all of these programmes and more. I am eager to tap into the deep expertise and experience you bring, which can inspire young people and strengthen our communities.

Thank you for joining us for an evening of meaningful discussions, shared experiences, and renewed connections. I look forward to an enriching evening with all of you.
