

Expression of Interest Blended Learning Training

Do you want to be a blended learning teacher?

If you can answer **YES** to these questions*, you might qualify for a **fully-sponsored British Council training** course:

- 1. Have you got a Cambridge CELTA?
- 2. Have you got teaching experience?
- 3. Can you demonstrate interest in/experience of e-learning or remote teaching?

The training will take place in July - August (approximately six hours a week for eight weeks). You must commit to being available during this period.

On successful completion of this course, you will get a certificate as an e-moderator and e-learning teacher. You may also be eligible to apply for a British Council blended teaching job.

* These are essential criteria. Please apply only if you meet these criteria.

Locations

The training programme will be conducted online. However, blended learning involves both face-to-face and online teaching. Therefore, we are primarily looking for teachers based in and around Delhi, Mumbai, Pune, Chennai and Bangalore. Teachers in neighbouring cities may also apply.

The deadline for applications is Friday 12 June.
