



IBSA BURSARY FOR BRITISH COUNCIL ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLASSES

The British Council and Indo-British Scholars Association are pleased to announce a bursary to enable meritorious students to pursue short term English language courses at the British Council Teaching Centre, Kolkata. Applications are currently open for 2019-20.

Eligibility:

- This bursary is available to individuals of age 16 years and above
- This bursary is available to individuals whose annual family income does not exceed INR two lakh (INR 2,00,000) per annum.
- Minimum education qualification: Should have passed Class 10 from any board.
- The candidate should not be in receipt of any other scholarship.

Process:

Application should be made by the candidate on email to <u>Dipika.Parial@britishcouncil.org</u> or in hard copy. The latter should be delivered to the reception at British Council, 1st Floor, L&T Chambers, 16 Camac Street, Kolkata 700017 in a sealed envelope.

The application should include:

- proof of being a student/employee of a bonafide organisation.
- proof of identity (the bursary is open to all Indian nationals)
- income proof or a letter from head of institute/school/college/employer certifying that annual income of the family is below INR 2 lakh.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to sit for a level test (free of cost) to assess their present level of English knowledge. An appropriate course will be suggested for them on the basis of the results of this level test.

Selected candidates will attend a short-term course of between 4-8 weeks duration. The fees will be covered by the bursary directly. No transport or accommodation allowances will be provided, and candidates will need to make their own conveyance arrangements.

Candidates with 100% attendance will receive a certificate on completion of the course.

Note: British Council's decision is final in all matters pertaining to selection as well as identification of class/module.
